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Tonight: Tuesday Night (Post-Early Voting)

- Rest, eat, hydrate.
- Tomorrow begins a 3-day sprint with 12-hour minimum workdays.
- You must be physically and mentally prepared.

Day 1: Wednesday — Organize, Prioritize, Call Relentlessly

7:00 AM - Get Organized

- Coffee in hand, notebook open.
- List every helper you can mobilize.
- Assign tasks: callers, texters, door-knockers, drivers.

Morning – Watch for Early Voting Turnout Reports

- When county turnout data drops (usually between 10 AM–2 PM):
 - Scrub your voter list remove everyone who already voted.
 - The rest are your universe to target.

Morning – Build Priority Lists

- Rank remaining voters:
 - 1. Committed supporters
 - 2. Leaners
 - 3. Persuadables
 - 4. Low-turnout voters

Break these into **chunks of 50 names** for outreach.

Candidate's Mission: Minimum 100 Personal Calls

- The Candidate must personally make at least 100 calls TODAY.
- More is better.
- Every minute not spent calling a voter = helping a volunteer call voters.

As a candidate, you are the most persuasive messenger.

No one else can close voters the way you can.

Day 2: Thursday — Relentless Contact and Energy Building

7:00 AM - Caffeine and Lists

- New lists ready. Volunteers prepped.
- Morning volunteer rally call or group text to set the tone.

Morning-Afternoon: Calls, Texts, Doors

- 3-hour outreach shifts:
 - Call top supporters.
 - Text everyone else.
 - Knock on highest-priority doors if possible.

Candidate's Mission: Another 100+ Calls

- Aim to finish first 100 by early afternoon.
- Stretch goal: 150-200 calls.
- Document responses: Yes / No / Maybe / Needs Follow-up.

Social Push

Energize your online base:

"Momentum is growing — your vote is powerful! Saturday is the day!"

Day 3: Friday — Final Outreach Surge

7:00 AM – Final Strategy Call with Team

Confirm poll greeters, sign crews, drivers for Saturday.

Morning-Evening: All-Out Outreach

- All voters on your list must be contacted by 6 PM Friday.
- Focus shifts to persuading and solidifying plans to vote.

Candidate's Mission: 100+ Direct Voter Contacts

- Again: direct voter calls are your #1 job today.
- Target high-priority voters who haven't been reached yet.

Saturday: ELECTION DAY — Execution Mode

6:30 AM - Team Launch

· Quick rally and reminder:

"Every vote matters. Every voter matters. Let's finish strong!"

7:00 AM-7:00 PM: GOTV Wall-to-Wall

- Poll greeters smile and engage.
- Call/text remaining voters until polls close.
- Offer rides, information, encouragement.

Candidate's Mission: Voter Visibility

- Greet voters at polls when possible.
- Make quick check-in calls to critical voters who pledged to support you.

Golden Rule for the Candidate:

Talk to voters. Help your team talk to voters.

Every minute of every day until polls close.

Sample Text Messages

Wednesday Texts (Organize Momentum – Build Excitement)

1. Friendly Welcome

"Hi [First Name], it's [Candidate Name]! We're gearing up for Election Day THIS Saturday. Thanks for being part of the team! Let's make a plan to vote and bring this home together! ■"

2. Mission-Oriented

"This is [Candidate Name] — 3 days left! Every conversation, every vote matters now. Can I count on you to vote Saturday and help us finish strong?"

3. Early Push

"Hi [First Name], early voting is done — now it's all about Saturday! ♥ We're organized, energized, and ready to WIN. Let's do this together!"

4. Peer Momentum

"Hey [First Name], neighbors across [City/County] are getting ready to vote Saturday! Are you with us? [Candidate Name] is fighting for [local issue] — let's finish the job!"

Thursday Texts (Energy + Urgency)

1. Countdown Energy

5. Ask + Thanks

Friday Texts (Finalize Voting Plans)

1. Plan Maker

Midday Motivation (12 PM - 3 PM)

4. Energy Boost

"Still plenty of time to vote! [First Name], you have the power to decide our future. Let's do this — polls open until [time]!"

5. Status Check

"Hey [First Name], have you voted yet? If not, there's still time to make your voice heard for [Candidate Name]! Need help? Just reply."

Late Afternoon Push (4 PM – 6:30 PM)

6. Last Call Energy

"Polls close soon, [First Name]! 🅯 If you haven't voted yet, this is the moment. Let's finish strong every vote matters!"

7. Urgent Nudge

" [First Name], final hours to vote for [Candidate Name]! If you're in line when polls close, you can still vote. Don't wait!"



Pro Tips for Sending These:

- Mix "friendly" texts with "urgent" ones every day.
- Use emojis sparingly to boost emotional energy.
- Always offer polling info or help.
- Personalize when possible ("Thanks for standing with us, [First Name]!")
- If possible, **send live updates**
- "Turnout is strong be part of the movement!"

Sample Call Scripts

Script 1 – Strong Supporters

Hi [Name], it's [Volunteer/Candidate Name] with [Campaign Name].

I'm calling because tomorrow is Election Day and your vote can make the difference.

Can I count on you to vote for [Candidate Name] on Saturday?

(If yes) Great! Polls are open from [times]. Do you know where you're voting?

(If no) Totally understand. If you have any questions about what's at stake, I'm happy to share.

Script 2 – Leaners / Persuadables

Hi [Name], it's [Volunteer/Candidate Name] with [Campaign Name].

We're working hard to elect leaders who will [name top priority issues: protect parental rights, fix local roads, etc.].

Have you decided who you're supporting for [Position]?

(If undecided)

Script 3 – Final Day Call (Saturday)
